**Open Book Exchange:** Mr. Smith will be available in the library during period 1 every day 1, 3, 5 and during period 8 every day 2 & 4 for open book exchange. This will allow a few students from each class to come down and exchange library books as they need to during the classes literacy blocks. We have moved to this system to use class learning time effectively as we know that not every student is ready to exchange their library books at a given whole class sign out period once a week and other students may be ready for a new book much sooner than their assigned day. Please encourage students to come to school with their library books whenever they are ready to exchange them and classroom teachers will establish a system of sending their students to visit the library during these times.
