



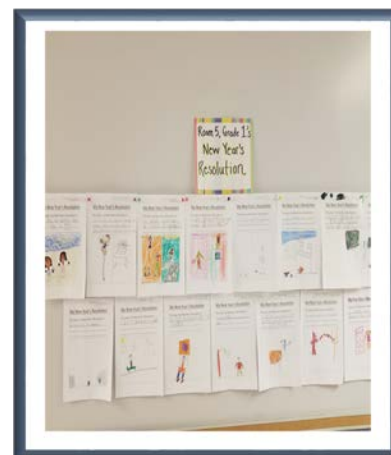

**Winter Weather:** With colder temperatures upon us, please ensure your child comes to school dressed to be outdoors. The TDSB cold weather policy is listed below and as you will see we do go outside on days when it is cold.

“Elementary school students are kept indoors for recess and lunch times for a number of weather conditions such as rain, lightning in the area, extreme winds and extreme cold. When temperature and wind chill measure -28C or lower, students are kept indoors. Recesses and lunch hour may be shortened if the temperature and wind chill reading is between -20C and -28C.”

**Lunchroom:** Please remember to send your child with a spoon or fork if it is needed in their lunch. As an eco-school we are not able to provide plastic cutlery.
