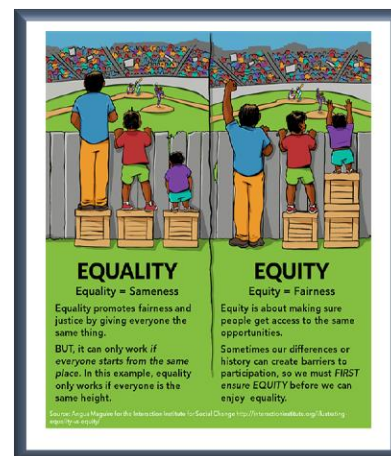

Coronavirus: The TDSB continues to send electronic messages to families about the coronavirus. For those who have not received this, the following is the most recent message from the Board:

The Toronto District School Board continues to take its lead from Toronto Public Health and other public health agencies, which have not advised our schools to take any additional precautions at this time. They also continue to advise that the risk to the public remains low.”
