Changing Between Virtual and In-person School:

Families should have received an e-mail from the TDSB late last week outlining the changes to the policy to switch to or from virtual school. There will no longer be a November switch date. The next opportunity is scheduled for the end of term 1 (late January) in order to provide greater stability to classes and staffing in-person and virtually. We will share specific dates to make your decisions as they become available.

Halloween:

We will be celebrating Halloween as our first spirit day on Friday! Students may wish to dress up in a costume for school on Friday. To ensure this is a fun, but safe event given the current health protocols, we ask that families adhere to the following:

1. COVID masks must be worn with all costumes while students are indoors as usual
2. No replica weapons/full face masks should be brought to school as part of a costume
3. No food, candy, stickers etc. should be sent to school to be shared among classmates to adhere to Public Health guidelines (classes may decide to have a special event like a movie, but will not be sharing food)
