DEFINITIONS

NO PARKING

Fine amount \$50.00



You may stop (temporarily) in a *No Parking* area only while actually engaged in picking up or dropping off passengers or merchandise. They get in or out — **you don't**.

- You may not leave your vehicle for a couple of minutes to take your child into the school. Leaving your vehicle—or even just waiting—is an offence.
- It is an offence to park closer than 9 meters of a corner. No sign is required.

NO STOPPING

Fine amount \$60.00 (increases to \$150 in a rush hour route)



Stopping to pick up or drop off is strictly not allowed.

Stopping is only allowed when:

- Directed to stop by a police officer, a traffic sign or a traffic light
- Avoiding a collision with other vehicles or pedestrians

SCHOOL BUS LOADING ZONE

Fine amount \$60.00



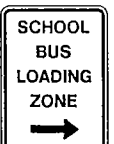
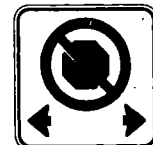
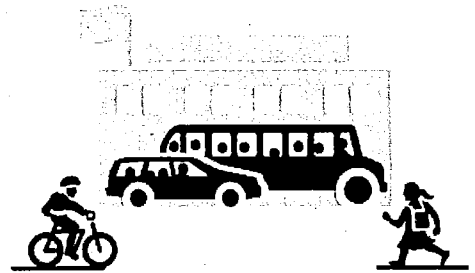
You may not stop or park in this area, not even briefly, to pick up or drop off passengers unless you are operating a school bus. This may be in effect 24 hours a day.
